

**Information to be transmitted to the ATQ database**

**RESTRICTIONS**

- It is prohibited to remove, or cause to be removed, from a farm enterprise in Quebec a bovine or ovine animal that is not identified in compliance with the *Regulation respecting the Identification and Traceability of Certain Animals (with two approved tags, one of which is electronic and the other with a bar code)*.
- It is prohibited to transport, or cause to be transported, an animal which is not identified ( the animal must have at least one tag);
- It is prohibited to remove, or cause to be removed, any identification tags that are affixed to the animals;
- the identification of an animal can only be done at the farm: you are not authorized to install approved tags on an animal in the vehicle.
- It is prohibited to make any erroneous, illegible or incomplete declarations concerning the information to be transmitted, when applying the regulations.

**OBLIGATIONS**

The livestock carrier must advise *Agri-Traçabilité Québec inc. (ATQ)* of all animals loaded and unloaded.

In this regard, the following information must be sent to ATQ:

- the carrier's stakeholder number (TRA 12345) that was attributed by ATQ and the registration number of the vehicle used to transport the animal;
- if the carrier uses a trailer or semi-trailer, the registration numbers of these must be indicated as well.

For each animal transported:

- the official identification number of the animal;
- the date and time of the animal's loading and unloading;
- the premises number of the animal's site of origin (where the animal was loaded in Quebec);
- the premises number of the animal's site of destination (where the animal was unloaded in Quebec);
- the name and address of the owner or custodian of the animal for ovine and bovine animals originating outside Quebec (location where the animal was loaded) or leaving Quebec (location where the animal was unloaded).

**DELAY PERIOD FOR TRANSMITTING DATA TO ATQ**

The livestock carrier must send this information to ATQ within seven (7) days following the transport of an animal.
