

Information to be transmitted to the ATQ database

RESTRICTIONS

- It is prohibited to receive, or cause to be received, an ovine or bovine animal which is not identified with approved tags.
- It is prohibited to make any erroneous, illegible or incomplete declarations concerning the information to be transmitted, when applying the *Regulation respecting the Identification and Traceability of Certain Animals*.
- It is prohibited to remove, or cause to be removed, any identification tags that are affixed to the animals.

OBLIGATIONS

The person in charge at the animal test station must advise *Agri-Traçabilité Québec inc. (ATQ)* of all animal arrivals and departures. (A departure declaration is optional for a bovine animal remaining in Quebec after passing through the test station).

In this regard, the following information must be sent to ATQ:

- the animal test station's stakeholder number (STA 12345) and its premises number (7-digit number) that were attributed to it by ATQ;
- the official identification number of the animal;
- the date of arrival and date of departure of the animal;
- the name and address of the owner or custodian of the animal at its loading and unloading sites;
- the premises numbers of the animal's sites of origin and destination:
If this information is not known, then the following must be provided:
 - the name and address of the carrier;
 - the registration number of the vehicle used to transport the animal.

DELAY PERIOD FOR TRANSMITTING DATA TO ATQ

The person in charge at the animal test station must send this information to ATQ within seven (7) days of the event.
